Aim

- To provide programs which support the child's self-esteem and pride in their family, community and linguistic heritage.
- To acknowledge backgrounds and cultures of a wide variety.

Strategies

- Program music, cooking, singing, dancing and craft activities from varied cultural backgrounds (including backgrounds relevant to the families attending the centre) on an ongoing basis.
- Provide books, play equipment and resources from varied cultural backgrounds.
- Program planning based on individual observations of individual children.
- Provide opportunity to become competent in English, while supporting 'home' language.
- Access and provide information, resources and support to families from culturally diverse backgrounds.
- Invite and include cultural activities of families, educators and the broader community where possible into the preschool program.
