What's On at Preschool...

In the Bungaree Room the children have continued to follow their interest in the ocean and fishing, trucks and transport as well as cultural language and knowledge. In the Bidhu Room the children have been interested in the changing weather, insects and first responders with our educators and teachers extending these interests with a variety of activities, experiences and games. We have been practicing our emergency drills and created a wonderful banner to acknowledge and say thank you to our fabulous paramedics, firies, police and SES. At home you can remind children if they or someone they see needs help they should find a grown up. If there are no grownups and it is an emergency, then they can stay calm, phone "000" and ask for help. Teach your child their home address and what to say. You could talk to your child about where the safe place outside your home is in case of a fire or other emergency. All families hope that their child will not have to take charge in an emergency, but even young children are capable of getting help if they are well prepared.

Responsible Children:

Personal responsibility is all about respect for not only yourself but others, including family and friends. Teaching your child to do things for themselves increases their self-achievement, self-esteem, sense of identity and independence. Children are capable and confident to do so much!! Even young children are able to dress and undress themselves, wash their own face, brush their teeth and hair, pack their own bags and lunches. It is sometimes easier and quicker for families to do these simple things automatically for their child, but in doing so you deprive your child of opportunities to enhance feelings of self-worth by taking responsibility for themselves. It might be quicker, but it also stops children from being confident and capable if adults are doing these things for them. At preschool the children are learning (if they haven't already) to look after their own belonging, go to the toilet independently (including wiping poos!!!), wash their hands, blow their nose, put on their own shoes and socks, open and pack their own bags, lunch boxes and drink bottles.

Families can help by practising these things at home but also making sure children's clothing and shoes are easy for them to put on and off, they can open and close their own school bags, lunch boxes and drink bottles and they can easily access the toilet and basin for self-care skills (especially if they are off to school next year). Jobs at home might also include putting their own dirty washing in the washing machine, making their bed, cleaning their room/toys. Making it fun by using reward charts, playing clean up games and songs etc can support your child to be independent and responsible.

Fee Increase

The Board of Directors have agreed to an increase in Long Day Care fees from July 1^{st} 2023. A regular day will now cost \$100 per day and a casual day will cost \$110 per day. Please see the attached letter for more information. If you have any concerns please see Narelle.
