Safety Over Summer

A big thank you to everyone for their patience and support during the recent local fire events. Our thoughts are with those who have been impacted by the fires. In consultation with the NSW Rural Fire Service and Department of Education, our preschool is reviewing and updating our Emergency and Bushfire Response Policies. We recommend that families also stay up to date with bushfire and grassfire activity by using the Hazards Near Me app (set a watch zone for your school area), and by monitoring local media. You can also review fire activity and alert levels on the RFS website. The Fire Danger Rating does not mean there will be a bushfire, but rather weather conditions that could pose a high risk for a bushfire event. The measure is proactive to ensure staff, students and the community remain safe. We recommend that all our families follow the advice of the NSW Rural Fire Service and ensure that your family knows what to do if there is a fire. It can take as little as five minutes to make your plan. Discuss it with your family so you know what you will do in the event of a fire.

We understand that managing the bushfire season maybe be a stressful time for staff and families alike. We are working together NSW RFS and NSW Department of Education to support our preschool children, families, staff and the broader community to help us maintain safe and normal service operations as much as possible. Please note that unpredictability may continue, with possible changes on short notice. We advise families to be prepared for these changes. Thank you for your continued patience and understanding and please be kind to our staff who are doing their best to keep your child, other families, our staff, and the broader community safe.

Sun Safety

A reminder to all families to ensure your child wears sun safe clothing to preschool, clothing that covers as much skin as possible. Choose lightweight, loose-fitting clothing that won't make your child too hot). At preschool the children engaged with many activities and are independently attempting to ensure their own sun safety. They were strategically taught how to apply their own sunscreen and wear their own preschool hat, things they can continue to do at home or while out and about over summer. Policy Update

Services are legally required to ensure families are notified of any changes to policies which affect: the service's provision of education and care to any enrolled child or a family's ability to use the service; fees; or fee collection procedures, 14 days in advance. (Education and Care Services National Regulations 2011). Bermagui Preschool is currently reviewing the Policy 2.02 Staff Employment, 4.16 Emergency Procedures (Evacuation and Lockdown) and 4.33 Bushfire Emergency Plan Policies.
