### RE-ENROLMENT and ORIENTATION DAY 2024

We are looking forward to having an exciting and fun filled 2024 together at Bermagui Preschool.

If you are returning or enrolling at Bermagui Preschool in 2024, we would like to invite you to attend a re-enrolment and orientation session at the Bermagui Preschool on **Tuesday 30**<sup>th</sup> **January 2024**. During this time all enrolment details will be checked and updated, and you will have a chance to talk to the Preschool staff about your child's program for 2024 and share information to help your child settle into Preschool. Please note short 30-minute visits for each family will be staggered through this day, with our regular Preschool and Long Day Care Programs resuming on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> January 2024.

On your child's first day at Preschool, please bring the following:

- A bag big enough for a lunch box, drink bottle, spare clothing and artwork.
- A spare set of clothing.
- A lunch box that your child can easily open, containing a nutritious morning tea and lunch and a separate piece of fruit for our fruit basket.
- Please remember we are a Nut Free Preschool. Nude Food (food without wrappers) is also preferred.
- A drink bottle containing water.

Please ensure all property including shoes are clearly marked with your child's name. Every care is taken but no liability can be accepted for lost or damaged property.

Please inform the preschool staff if you will be unavoidably early, or late, or not attending, so we can accommodate your needs or offer places to others who require an extra day. Attendance outside your regular booked hours will incur additional fees.

If you are no longer intending to enrol your child this term, please let Kirsty know as there are other children who are waiting for a place.

### POLICY UPDATE

Services are legally required to ensure families are notified of any changes to policies which affect: the service's provision of education and care to any enrolled child or a family's ability to use the service; fees; or fee collection procedures, 14 days in advance. (Education and Care Services National Regulations 2011). Bermagui Preschool is currently reviewing the following policies 2.03 Approved Providers and Board of Directors Responsibility, 2.07 Nominated Supervisor, 2.08 Responsible Person, 2.09 Educational Leader, 2.10 Staff Code of Conduct, 2.12 Record Keeping and Retention of Records, 2.13 Notification to the Regulatory Authority, 2.14 Stand Down, 3.01 Enrolment and Orientation, 3.02 Additional Needs, and 3.03 Fees. Copies of the existing policy are available on our website and the proposed Policy is available at Preschool for families to review and provide feedback. Written feedback can be emailed to us.

### OXFAM UNWRAPPED GIFTS


