Blue Book Development Milestones and Health and Development Checks

Your child's early development is a journey with important <u>milestones</u> along the way. Your doctor or <u>child and family health nurse</u> tracks these during your child's routine health and development checks. Health and development checks are very important. They help you track how your child is growing and developing by looking at how they play, learn, speak, act, and move. There are 8 health and development checks, which you'll find in your child's <u>Blue Book</u>. You can track your child's development using <u>these checklists</u>. If you have any concerns about how they are developing, share them with your child and family health nurse or doctor.

Services are legally required to ensure families are notified of any changes to policies which affect: the service's provision of education and care to any enrolled child or a family's ability to use the service; fees; or fee collection procedures, 14 days in advance. (Education and Care Services National Regulations 2011). Bermagui Preschool is currently reviewing 1.01 Philosophy, 2.10 Staff Code of Conduct, 2.12 Record keeping and Retention of Records, 2.13 Notification to the Regulatory Authority, 2.14 Stand Down, 3.01 Enrolment and Orientation, 3.02 Additional Needs.
