## **Bushfire Season**

With summer approaching, we should all review and consider bushfire emergency planning and preparedness. This includes:

- reviewing and updating emergency plans and risk assessments
- using available tools such as NSW RFS bushfire prone land mapping tool, bushfire survival plan and Know your risk website to monitor local conditions

We would also like to remind families, in accordance with Bermagui Preschool Bushfire Emergency Plan, if Bermagui area has a **Catastrophic** or **Extreme** Fire Danger Rating, please keep children at home as Bermagui Preschool will be closed. Bermagui Preschool will also be closed or close immediately if a Watch and Act **A** Bushfire Alert is activated.

If there is a day with a High Fire Danger Rating and/or dangerous fire conditions in the local area surrounding Bermagui, you will need to:

- Consider not sending your child to Preschool
- Monitor local radio, NSW RFS FIRES NEAR ME app and phone alerts
- Have a plan in place to collect your child immediately, if necessary
- Leave contact numbers where you can be reached at all times during the day

**Tressilian Support** are running a 'Getting to Know You' group for mothers with babies 0-6 months on the 12th of November in the Library Hall. It then runs for the consecutive 2 Tuesdays 10:30am-12:30pm. Parents can log on and refer themselves at <u>Tresillian.org.au</u>. Parents can go to courses and then to the section for parents.

Hi to all mums with children under 3 years of age, our names are Maria (Child and Family Health Nurse) and Sasha (Aboriginal health worker). We work for Tresillian who are part of NSW Health and are free under Medicare. Our Centre is based at Moruya, but we now provide an outreach service to Catalina, Narooma, Mogo, Bermagui and Wallaga Lake. We will be in the information centre car park of Bermagui every second Thursday from 31/10/24 and the alternate Thursdays at Little Yuin Preschool Wallaga Lake in a giant T2U van.

We can provide support with feeding (breast, bottle, solids), sleep and settling, routines, toddler behaviour, toilet training, and how you are feeling about parenting.
