### Preschool Hours

Bermagui Preschool's hours of operation are 8:15am-3:45pm. Children will need to be signed out by 3:45pm to avoid late fee charges. We thank our families, educators and children for their support and understanding that the 15 minutes before and after these times each day is important non-contact time for our teachers and educators to develop preschool programs, prepare preschool activities, attend to cleaning and engage in staff meetings and critical reflection. Please see Narelle for further information if needed.

### Children's Lockers

Inside your child's Preschool room there are lockers for all children. This space is where each child can keep their bags and personal belongings. We will put artwork and other important Preschool information in these lockers. Newsletters and fees notices are sent electronically, unless families request a paper copy. We ask that families please provide a bag, drink bottle and lunch box that a child can manage independently (i.e. not too big, not too small, able to be opened and closed independently).

## Sharing Information with our Families

We post Preschool information through our online system "Educate", the Bermagui Preschool Facebook page, emails and our noticeboard at the front gate at Preschool for families to read. A reminder to families that a HubHello App is available to easily access Preschool information regarding your child, including photos, learning stories and enrolment information. The Preschool children will also keep work in their portfolios that will be presented at the end of each year.

## Pick Up and Drop Off at Bermagui Preschool:

Educators will be available to meet and greet you in each room. We invite families to come into the room, help their child unpack their lunch box and drink bottle and find a locker for their bag. If families need support to help say goodbye to their children our teachers and educators can be there to help.

If families require a detailed conversation with our educators, please discuss a mutually convenient time to organise a meeting, as at times it can be quite busy, and exchange of important information can be challenging.

On arrival and at the end of the day please remember to sign your child in and out. Children eligible for 2 days of Preschool need to sign into the Preschool iPad/QR Code for the first two days of the week and then the Long Day Care iPad/QR Code for all additional days. All other children need to sign into the Long Day Care iPad/QR Code. A reminder to all families, it is a legal requirement to sign your child in and out of Preschool each day. This can be done on your own mobile device using our QR codes or on the iPads provided.

### Settling in at Preschool

Although we hope to have a happy start to Preschool, occasionally separation anxiety may occur when you drop your child off at Preschool. If you find your child is a clingy, crying or needing support, you may find the following tips helpful.

- © Bring a comforter, a favourite toy, book, photo or activity from home that your child is excited about and can share with their teachers and friends and can be used to comfort them if they are anxious.
- Help settle your child in at Preschool by joining in an activity happily and enthusiastically. Children pick up on adult vibes very easily. If you show enjoyment and happiness about Preschool activities, they are more likely to also be enthusiastic about Preschool.
- When it is time to go, say goodbye quickly, as this is the most stressful period, and anxiety will be lessened if goodbyes are warm and brief. Try not to sneak off without saying goodbye as this can lead to further anxiety, mistrust and doesn't allow children to develop the skills needed to separate positively. Please let staff know if you and your child need help before you say goodbye.
- © If your child senses that you are confident in leaving them in our caring hands it will help them to also feel strong.

If you have ongoing concerns about separation anxiety, please talk to staff so the best support can be given.

### Fees Information

A fee notice will be sent out shortly. Fees are due to be paid each term and are due 2 weeks after receipt of your fee notice. Parents can arrange a regular payment plan with Kirsty in the office if this is more convenient for your family. Details regarding the Child Care Subsidy are available online through Centrelink (myGov). Families become members of the Bermagui Preschool Cooperative Society when fees are paid and are then able to vote at the AGM.

#### Preschool T-Shirts
