## Policy Update

As required by the Education and Care Services National Regulations, services must notify families of any changes to policies affecting the provision of education and care to any enrolled child or a family's ability to use the service and fees or fee collection procedures. Families will be given 14 days' notice before any changes take effect. Bermagui Preschool is currently reviewing the following policies: 4.15 Death and 4.16 Emergency Procedures (Evacuation and Lockdown). Current policies are available on our website, and proposed updates can be viewed at Preschool for families to review and provide feedback.
